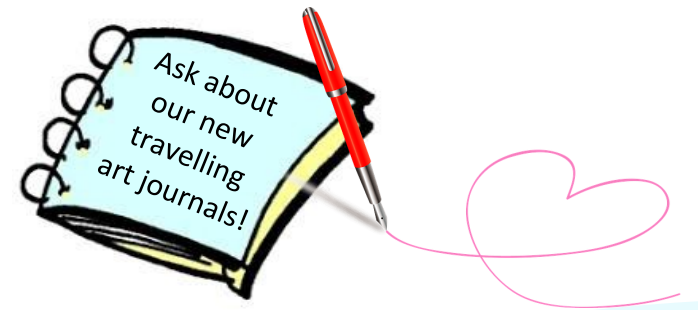
Fri. 19th, 1pm: Lunch Book Club
